GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

- (1) Proclamation under section 198 of the *Local Government (Building and Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1993*

This proclamation declares –

- (a) that certain land known as the Cove Hill Restricted Supply Water District ceases to be a water district; and
- (b) certain land to be a restricted supply water district and names that district the Cove Hill Restricted Supply Water District; and
- (c) certain land to be a water district and names that district the Cove Hill Water District.
