### FEE UNITS ACT 1997

THE *Fee Units Act 1997* provides for automatic changes in Government fees and charges in accordance with movements in the Hobart Consumer Price Index (CPI). The Fee Units Act also provides for adjustments to be made on the basis of factors other than movements in the CPI through a fee unit adjustment factor.

In accordance with section 5 of the Fee Units Act, the value of a fee unit is increased by the CPI increase and for 2012–13 will be \$1.44.

I have determined the fee unit adjustment factor for 2012–13 to be zero for the purposes of section 5(4) of the Fee Units Act.

In determining the value of the fee unit adjustment factor, I am satisfied that there were no special factors that would warrant the discounting of the increase in the value of a fee unit in 2012–13 below the CPI increase.

#### GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

##### (1) *Land Tax Amendment Regulations 2012*

These regulations amend the *Land Tax Regulations 2010* by prescribing, for the purposes of the definition of “owner” in section 3A of the *Land Tax Act 2000*, classes of persons who are owners in respect of land not registered under the *Land Titles Act 1980*.

##### (2) Proclamation under section 11(2) of the *Nature Conservation Act 2002*

This proclamation, under the *Nature Conservation Act 2002* –

- (a) declares certain areas of Crown land to be reserved land in the class of conservation area; and
- (b) in doing so, creates and names certain new conservation areas and extends certain existing conservation areas.

##### (3) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Vocational Education and Training (Commonwealth Powers) Act 2011*

This proclamation fixes 15 February 2012 as the day on which the *Vocational Education and Training (Commonwealth Powers) Act 2011* commences.
