NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF STATUTORY RULES

In accordance with the provisions of the Rules Publication Act 1953, notice is given of the making of the following statutory rules:-

GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

- Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Amendment Regulations 2023
 These regulations amend the Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2021 by providing for an exemption from certain licensing requirements for postal workers operating a motor trike in specified circumstances.
- (2) Primary Produce Safety (General) Regulations 2023
 - These regulations -
 - (a) prescribe, for the purposes of the Primary Produce Safety Act 2011 -
 - (i) the application fee for an application for approval to be a food safety auditor; and
 - (ii) infringement notice offences and the penalties payable for those infringement notice offences; and
 - (b) rescind the Primary Produce Safety (General) Regulations 2014.
- (3) Primary Produce Safety (Seafood) Regulations 2023

These regulations -

(a) prescribe, for the purposes of the Primary Produce Safety Act 2011 –

- (i) the food safety scheme in respect of seafood; and
- (ii) the accreditation requirements in respect of the production of seafood; and
- (iii) other miscellaneous matters in relation to seafood; and
- (b) rescind the Primary Produce Safety (Seafood) Regulations 2014.
