GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2021

These regulations -

- (a) for the purposes of the Vehicle and Traffic Act 1999
 - (i) provide for matters relating to driver licensing, vehicle registration, motor tax and related matters; and
 - (ii) prescribe fees payable and demerit points applicable to those matters; and
- (b) are made consequent on the repeal of the *Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2010* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992.*
- (2) Vehicle and Traffic (Review of Decisions) Amendment Regulations 2021

These regulations amend the Vehicle and Traffic (Review of Decisions) Regulations 2010 by updating certain references consequent on the commencement of the Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2021.

(3) Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Standards) Amendment Regulations 2021

These regulations amend the Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Standards) Regulations 2014 consequent on the commencement of the Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2021.

(4) Traffic (Compliance and Enforcement) Amendment Regulations 2021

These regulations amend the Traffic (Compliance and Enforcement) Regulations 2017 by -

- (a) updating certain references consequent on the commencement of the *Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2021*; and
- (b) inserting a new offence under the *Road Rules 2019*, for which an infringement notice may be issued under the *Traffic Act 1925*.
- (5) Motor Accidents (Liabilities and Compensation) Amendment Regulations 2021

These regulations amend the *Motor Accidents (Liabilities and Compensation) Regulations 2020* consequent on the commencement of the *Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2021*.

(6) Road Amendment Rules 2021

These rules amend the Road Rules consequent on the commencement of the Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2021.

(7) Poisons Amendment Regulations 2021

These regulations amend the *Poisons Regulations 2018* by providing for the administration, in specified circumstances, of certain vaccines that are restricted substances.
