LIVING MARINE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1995

PUBLIC NOTICE – ALTERATION OF MANAGEMENT PLAN REGARDING THE SCALEFISH FISHERY

SECTION 57 OF THE *LIVING MARINE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1995*

Pursuant to the powers under the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* ("the Act") that were delegated to the General Manager (Marine Resources) by the Secretary acting pursuant to section 20(2) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*, I hereby give notice that:

- As a result of review, the management plan regarding the scalefish fishery in the form of the *Fisheries (Scalefish) Rules 2015* is to be altered by the *Fisheries (Scalefish) Amendment Rules 2023*.
- Details of the alterations are as follows:
 - a) Extending the duration of the rules until 1 November 2026; and
 - b) Updating certain catch limits for scalefish; and
 - c) Clarifying what equipment may be possessed and used by certain licence holders; and
 - d) Making other minor revisions to the rules.
- The date on which these alterations take effect is 1 November 2023.

Any expression used in this public notice having a particular meaning under the Act has the same meaning in this public notice as it has in the Act.
