GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Land Titles Regulations 2022*

These regulations –

- (a) make provision in respect of various matters including the lodgment of dealings and applications under, and for the purposes of, the *Land Titles Act 1980*; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Land Titles Regulations 2012* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(2) *Registration of Deeds Regulations 2022*

These regulations –

- (a) make provision in respect of various matters relating to the lodgment or registration of documents under the *Registration of Deeds Act 1935*; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Registration of Deeds Regulations 2012* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(3) *Conveyancing and Law of Property Regulations 2022*

These regulations –

- (a) detail the procedure for determining certain applications made under the *Conveyancing and Law of Property Act 1884*; and
- (b) detail the powers of the Recorder of Titles in determining such applications; and
- (c) make provision for the lodgment of certain documents in such applications; and
- (d) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Conveyancing and Law of Property Regulations 2012* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(4) *Conveyancing and Law of Property (Building Title Plans) Regulations 2022*

These regulations –

- (a) provide for various matters in relation to building title plans under Division 2 of Part XI of the *Conveyancing and Law of Property Act 1884*; and
- (b) are made consequent on the repeal of the *Conveyancing and Law of Property (Building Titles Plans) Regulations 2012* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.
