## Anti-Discrimination

### ANTI-DISCRIMINATION ACT 1998

#### ANTI-DISCRIMINATION COMMISSIONER, TASMANIA

#### EXEMPTION/S GRANTED

The following application for renewal of an exemption from the provisions of the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1998* (Tas) (the Act) has been granted:

Tasmanian Electoral Commission – 20/09/070 – Application for renewal of an exemption granted under section 57 of the Act for a further period of three (3) years.

1. This renewal of exemption is granted to enable the Tasmanian Electoral Commission (TEC) to request and consider information pertaining to the following criteria in determining whether or not a person should be: employed or appointed as a member of staff with the TEC; appointed as a returning officer or election official under section 24 or 26 of the *Electoral Act 2004* (Tas); or engaged as a contractor:
  - (a) Current membership, or membership within the past 5 years, of any political party in any State or Territory or the Commonwealth.
  - (b) A course of conduct within the past 5 years directed to supporting the aims of a political party or an independent candidate in a State, Territory or Federal election.
  - (c) A person who has held the office of councillor for a Tasmanian local council within the past 5 years.
  - (d) A course of conduct within the past 5 years directed towards supporting the political aims of a local councillor.
  - (e) A person who has publicly engaged in conduct promoting a political position in respect of an issue currently before the electorate in the election for which that person is to be employed.
  - (f) A person who is a member of a lobby group (not being a union or professional association) which promotes a political position in respect of an issue currently before the electorate in the election for which that person is to be employed.
2. The exemption does not exempt any other direct or indirect discrimination or prohibited conduct under the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1998* (Tas).

3. The exemption is for a further period of three (3) years subject to the fulfilment of the conditions that Tasmanian Electoral Commission:
  - (a) Provide all prospective and current employees with:
    - (i) notice that they may be adversely affected by the exemption;
    - (ii) a reasonable explanation in plain English of the nature of the exemption; and
    - (iii) information regarding their rights under the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1998* (Tas) and *Australian Human Rights Commission Act 1986* (Cth), and, in particular, the complaints procedure under those Acts and the rights of aggrieved persons to make complaints under those Acts.
  - (b) Within 12 months of the date this decision to renew the exemption, arrange for all current TEC staff to undertake a one hour free discrimination information session provided by Equal Opportunity Tasmania.
  - (c) Provide to the applicant's contractors:
    - (i) notice that the contractor's employees and prospective employees may be adversely affected by the exemption;
    - (ii) a document containing a reasonable explanation in plain English of the nature of this exemption order that the contractor may provide to the contractor's employees and prospective employees; and
    - (iii) guidance to enable the contractor to conduct training in anti-discrimination.

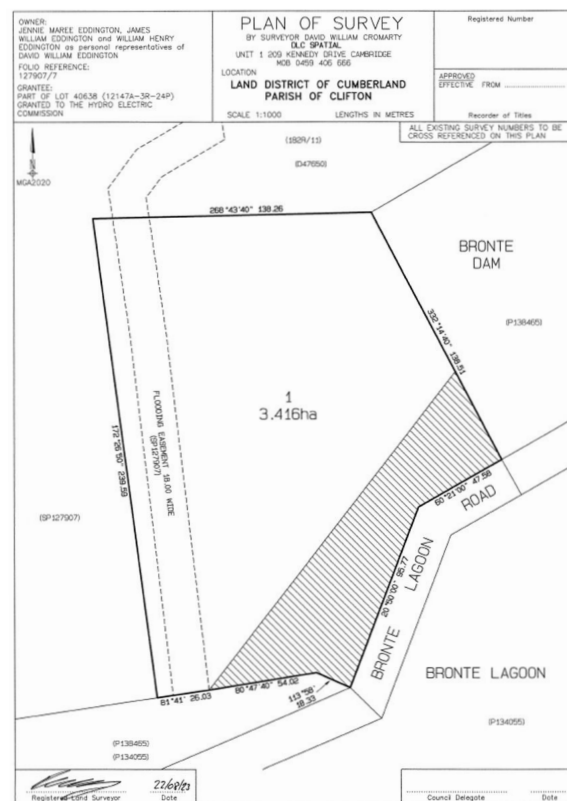

## Biosecurity

### DECLARATION OF PROHIBITED MATTER

#### *Biosecurity Act 2019*

##### Section 20

1. I, Andrew Bishop, being and as the Chief Plant Protection Officer and delegate of the Minister for Primary Industries and Water, hereby declare pursuant to section 20 of the *Biosecurity Act 2019* ("the Act") the biosecurity matter or classes of biosecurity matter listed in Schedule 1 below to be prohibited matter for the purposes of the Act, being satisfied that –
  - (a) the biosecurity matter or classes of biosecurity matter pose a significant biosecurity risk to Tasmania; and
  - (b) the declaration is necessary to prevent, eliminate, minimise, control or manage the biosecurity risk posed by the biosecurity matter or class of biosecurity matter.
2. This declaration is subject to the following provisions:
  - (a) any biosecurity matter that becomes prohibited matter because of this declaration may be lawfully disposed of, treated or destroyed –
    - (i) in accordance with a prohibited matter permit issued under the Act; or
    - (ii) in accordance with any biosecurity direction issued under the Act; or
    - (iii) under the supervision or direction of an authorised officer;
  - (b) section 74 of the Act does not apply in respect of the disposal, treatment or destruction of any biosecurity matter under paragraph (a) above.
3. This declaration takes effect on the date of its publication in the Gazette and remains in force until revoked.

#### *FISHERIES (ROCK LOBSTER) RULES 2022*

#### NOTICE – NON-COMMERCIAL FISHING REPORT

I, Dr Ian Dutton, General Manager (Marine Resources) in the Department of Natural Resources and Environment Tasmania (the Department), acting pursuant to a delegation from the Secretary, hereby determine pursuant to rule 108 of the *Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Rules 2022*, (the Rules) that from 13:00 hours on Thursday 2 November 2023 non-commercial fishers are to report to the Secretary the details of rock lobster taken, or rock lobster fishing undertaken as specified in the schedules 1-3 to this notice:

#### Schedule 1

- 1) The details to be included in the report by the holder of a recreational fishing licence (the fisher) are;
  - a) A going-fishing report which records
    - i) The date and time which the fisher intends to go fishing;
    - ii) The departure point;
    - iii) The method of fishing;
    - iv) Registration number of the boat that the fisher is fishing from if boat fishing; and
    - v) The name and licence number of any fisher whose trip is being logged under this going-fishing report;
  - b) A catch report for all holders of a recreational fishing licence reported under the going-fishing report which records;
    - i) What fishing method/s were used;
    - ii) The general location/s where fishing occurred;
    - iii) How many rock lobsters were kept (even if 0); and
    - iv) How many rock lobsters were released (even if 0).

**Schedule 2**

- 1) The circumstances in which the report is to be made are;
  - a) A going-fishing report is to be made within 24 hours prior to fishing;
  - b) A catch report is to be made on each day during which fishing occurs and must be completed before the fisher leaves the immediate proximity of the point of landing.

**Schedule 3**

- 1) The method by which the report is to be made is;
  - a) By the holder of a recreational fishing licence making their own report or by having a report completed on their behalf using the Fishing Tas App;
    - i) To report catch on behalf of someone else, a non-commercial fisher must be 18 years of age or above; and
    - ii) Be responsible for ensuring that all the provided information is true and correct;
  - b) Using the reporting service approved under section 98 of the Rules.

If, temporarily, a person is unable to make the report due to circumstances beyond their control, by maintaining a record in writing of the details as set out in (1)(a) before commencing fishing and maintaining a record of the details as set out in (1)(b) whilst fishing, and then making the report in accordance with (3)(a) or 3(b) at the first reasonable opportunity to do so.

**Fishing Tas App** means the software application that leverages the capabilities of iPhone (iOS) and Android smartphone or tablet devices to enable users to submit fishing reports required by this notice, via a secure Web Service or API to the server-side database held and maintained by the Department.

**Point of landing** means the location where the fisher first returns to land following a rock lobster fishing activity.

Unless otherwise defined in this notice, words and expressions used in this notice have the same meaning as in the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* and the *Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Rules 2022*.

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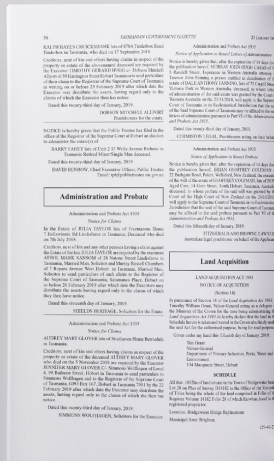
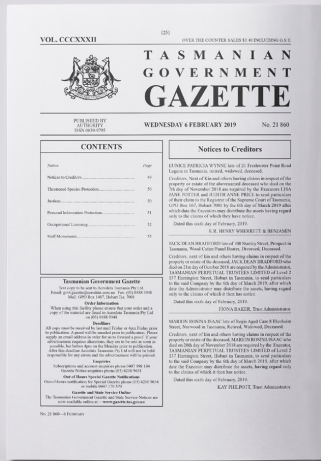
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
