NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF STATUTORY RULES

In accordance with the provisions of the Rules Publication Act 1953, notice is given of the making of the following statutory rules:-

# GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Nature Conservation (Wildlife) Regulations 2021

These regulations -

- (a) for the purposes of the Nature Conservation Act 2002
  - (i) enable licences and permits to be granted in relation to hunting, trading, taxidermy, display, possessing, and other related uses, of wildlife; and
  - (ii) classify certain wildlife as partly protected, protected, specially protected or restricted (special purpose) wildlife;
  - (iii) prescribe certain animals as restricted animals and domestic stock; and
- (b) repeal the Wildlife (General) Regulations 2010, the Wildlife (Exhibited Animals) Regulations 2010 and the Wildlife (General) Amendment (Browsing Animal Management) Regulations 2016.
- (2) Wildlife (Deer Farming) Regulations 2021

These regulations, made under Part 4 of the Nature Conservation Act 2002 -

- (a) regulate deer farming, including by requiring the approval of deer farm fences so as to prevent the escape of farm deer into the wild; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the Wildlife (Deer Farming) Regulations 2010 under section 11 of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1992.

(3) Financial Management Amendment Order 2021

This order amends the Financial Management Act 2016 by –

- (a) including the Environment Protection Authority as an Agency for the purposes of that Act; and
- (b) updating the name of an Agency to reflect the change in Department name.
