

#### Rule 5 of Fisheries (Giant Crab) Rules 2013 changed

Rule 5 of the Fisheries (Giant Crab) Rules 2013 is changed by omitting "10 years" and substituting "11 years".

**Explanatory note:** This order changes the management plan for the giant crab fishery by extending those rules by one year. The rules have been extended whilst the preparation of new rules for the fishery are completed.
