GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Animal Welfare (Transport of Livestock) Regulations (No. 2) 2023*

These regulations –

- (a) prescribe, for the purposes of the *Animal Welfare Act 1993*, transportation requirements for certain species of animal; and
- (b) rescind the *Animal Welfare (Transport of Livestock) Regulations 2023* which were rendered void, under section 47(3A) of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1931*, due to an inadvertently invalid commencement provision.

(2) *Animal Welfare (Pigs) Regulations (No. 2) 2023*

These regulations –

- (a) prescribe, for the purposes of the *Animal Welfare Act 1993* –
 - (i) requirements for ensuring the health and welfare of pigs in certain circumstances; and
 - (ii) matters relating to a Model Code of Practice for the Welfare of Animals: Pigs; and
 - (iii) infringement notice penalties; and
- (b) rescind the *Animal Welfare (Pigs) Regulations 2023* which were rendered void, under section 47(3A) of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1931*, due to an inadvertently invalid commencement provision.

(3) *Animal Welfare (General) Regulations (No. 2) 2023*

These regulations –

- (a) prescribe, for the purposes of the *Animal Welfare Act 1993* –
 - (i) certain requirements for ensuring the welfare of animals generally; and
 - (ii) matters relating to a Code of Practice for rodeos; and
 - (iii) fees payable by certain institutions for an application to carry out animal research; and
- (b) rescind the *Animal Welfare (General) Regulations 2023* which were rendered void, under section 47(3A) of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1931*, due to an inadvertently invalid commencement provision.

(4) *Animal Welfare (Domestic Poultry) Regulations (No. 2) 2023*

These regulations –

- (a) prescribe, for the purposes of the *Animal Welfare Act 1993* –
 - (i) requirements for ensuring the health and welfare of domestic poultry in certain circumstances; and
 - (ii) infringement notice penalties; and
- (b) rescind the *Animal Welfare (Domestic Poultry) Regulations 2023* which were rendered void, under section 47(3A) of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1931*, due to an inadvertently invalid commencement provision.

(5) *Animal Welfare (Sheep) Regulations 2023*

These regulations prescribe, for the purposes of the *Animal Welfare Act 1993*, requirements for ensuring the health and welfare of sheep in certain circumstances.
