RULES PUBLICATION ACT 1953

GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Fee Units Amendment Act 2023*This proclamation fixes 1 January 2024 as the day on which that Act commences.

(2) Container Refund Scheme Regulations 2023

These regulations provide for the following matters, in respect of the container refund scheme, for the purposes of the *Container Refund Scheme Act 2022*:

- (a) prescribing certain containers as being exempt from the scheme;
- (b) specifying who is the first responsible supplier under the scheme;
- (c) specifying the circumstances in which a refund is not payable under the scheme;
- (d) prescribing -
 - (i) the refund amount payable under the scheme in respect of a container; and
 - (ii) the marks required to be displayed on a container for a refund to be payable under the scheme; and
 - (iii) the maximum number of containers that may be deposited under the scheme at any one time;
- (e) prescribing certain requirements for scheme participants;
- (f) providing for guidelines to be published in respect of that Act and the scheme.
- (3) Proclamation under section 11(2) of the Nature Conservation Act 2002

This proclamation, under the Nature Conservation Act 2002 -

- (a) declares a certain area of Crown land to be reserved land in the class of regional reserve; and
- (b) in doing so, extends the existing Dismal Swamp Regional Reserve.
- (4) Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania) Regulations 2023

These regulations -

- (a) modify the application, in Tasmania, of certain provisions of the Heavy Vehicle (Vehicle Standards) National Regulation that relate to buses, window tinting of heavy vehicles, heavy vehicle's exhaust systems and the display of labels on heavy vehicles; and
- (b) provide for the determination of the mass and dimensions of heavy vehicles and their loads; and
- (c) prescribe offences for which infringement notices may be served under the Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania); and
- (d) replace the Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania) Regulations 2014.

(5) Poisons Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2023

These regulations amend the *Poisons Regulations 2018* by adding certain narcotic substances to the list of narcotic substances which a medical practitioner must not issue a prescription for, or supply to a patient, without the authority of the Secretary.


