GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Teachers Registration Regulations 2021

These regulations -

(a) prescribe fees that are payable under the Teachers Registration Act 2000; and

- (b) prescribe under section 26A of that Act the relevant authorities, and classes of relevant authorities, to whom information, in relation to persons who are or were registered teachers or holders of a limited authority, may be provided by the Board; and
- (c) prescribe certain purposes, in addition to the purposes specified in section 26A(1) of that Act, for which the information may be so provided; and
- (d) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Teachers Registration Regulations 2011* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.
- (2) Proclamation under section 2 of the Poisons Amendment Act 2021

This proclamation fixes 17 December 2021 as the day on which the provisions of that Act commence.

(3) Poisons Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2021

These regulations amend the Poisons Regulations 2018 to -

- (a) prescribe certain substances that are prescribed to be monitored medicines; and
- (b) prescribe certain persons who are prescribed as a dispenser; and
- (c) prescribe certain persons who are prescribed as a prescriber; and
- (d) prescribe the manner, and the form, in which a data source entity is to provide information to the monitored medicines database; and
- (e) prescribe certain information that is to be provided to, or collected and stored in, the monitored medicines database; and
- (f) prescribe certain offences as offences for which an infringement notice may be issued; and
- (g) rescind a provision of the regulations, for the sale or supply of certain restricted substances, that is no longer required.
- (4) Poisons Amendment Regulations (No. 4) 2021

These regulations amend the *Poisons Regulations 2018* by inserting additional controls on the possession and supply of ivermectin.

(5) Pharmacy Control (Fees) Regulations 2021

These regulations -

- (a) prescribe certain fees for the purposes of the *Pharmacy Control Act 2001*; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Pharmacy Control (Fees) Regulations 2010* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.
- (6) Occupational Licensing (Gas-fitting Work) Regulations 2021

These regulations -

- (a) prescribe a range of matters under, and for, the *Occupational Licensing Act 2005* in its application to gas-fitting work and automotive gas-fitting work including
 - (i) licensing procedures and related matters; and
 - (ii) rectification processes for defective work; and
 - (iii) infringement notice penalties and other penalties; and
 - (iv) licensing and other fees; and
 - (v) other miscellaneous matters; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the Occupational Licensing (Gas-fitting Work) Regulations 2010 under section 11 of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1992.
- (7) Occupational Licensing (Plumbing Work) Regulations 2021

These regulations -

- (a) prescribe a range of matters under, and for, the Occupational Licensing Act 2005 in its application to plumbing work including –
 - (i) licensing procedures and related matters; and
 - (ii) rectification processes for defective work; and
 - (iii) infringement notices; and
 - (iv) licensing and other fees; and
 - (v) other miscellaneous matters: and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the Occupational Licensing (Plumbing Work) Regulations 2010 under section 11 of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1992.

- (8) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Traffic Amendment (Personal Mobility Devices) Act 2021* This proclamation fixes 15 December 2021 as the day on which that Act commences.
- (9) Victims of Crime Assistance Regulations 2021

These regulations -

- (a) prescribe the maximum amount of an award of compensation under the *Victims of Crime Assistance Act 1976* and the information to be included in an application for such an award; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Victims of Crime Assistance Regulations 2010* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.
- (10) Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Amendment (Expanded Business Vehicle Support Package)
 Regulations 2021

These regulations amend the *Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2021* by allowing for waiving or remittance of certain registration fees payable or paid in respect of certain vehicles that are used to provide hire and drive passenger services, or passenger transport services, during the 6-month period commencing on 1 July 2021.

(11) Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Amendment Regulations (No. 5) 2021

These regulations amend the *Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2021* by reducing the fee units payable in relation to the testing or assessment of a driver in the novice driver learner stage for a class 'C' driver licence.
