- I, Jo Palmer, Minister administering the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* (the Act), pursuant to Section 94 (2)(b) and (c) of the Act, for the quota period from 1 March 2023 to 29 February 2024, hereby:
  - 1. Determine the area of State waters adjacent to the east coast of Tasmania bounded in the north on the east coast by the line of latitude at 41° 16′ 30" South running due east from St Helens Point and bounded in the south on the south east coast by the line of latitude at 43° 20′ 00" South running due east of Coal Point (Adventure Bay, Bruny Island), excluding the D'Entrecasteaux Channel and the River Derwent, to be the rock lobster *east coast catch-cap area*; and,
  - 2. Determine that the portion of the rock lobster total allowable commercial catch to be taken from the *east coast catch-cap* area is 94 tonnes.

  - 4. Determine that the portion of the rock lobster total allowable commercial catch to be taken from the *north east catch-cap* area is 100 tonnes.

# FISHERIES (GIANT CRAB MANAGEMENT PLAN) ORDER 2022

I make the following order under section 48A of the Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995.

### 1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Fisheries (Giant Crab Management Plan) Order 2022.

### 2. Commencement

This Order takes effect on the day on which it is published in the Gazette.

### 3. Rule 5 of Fisheries (Giant Crab) Rules 2013 changed

Rule 5 of the Fisheries (Giant Crab Rules) 2013\* is changed by omitting "10 years" and substituting "11 years".

(Explanatory note)

This Order extends the management plan for the giant crab fishery to provide continued operation of the management plan as implementation of new rules for the fishery is finalised.

### Public Notice – total allowable catch for the rock lobster fishery for the 2023-2024 quota period

I, Jo Palmer, Minister administering the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*, pursuant to Section 94 of that Act, for the quota period from 1 March 2023 to 29 February 2024, hereby:

- 1. Set the total allowable catch for the commercial rock lobster fishery and the recreational rock lobster fishery combined at 1,220,70 tonnes:
- 2. Determine that the parts of the fishery from which the total allowable catch is to be taken are the commercial rock lobster fishery and the recreational rock lobster fishery;
- 3. Determine that the portion of the total allowable catch to be taken from the commercial rock lobster fishery is 1,050.70 tonnes; and,
- 4. Determine that the portion of the total allowable catch to be taken from the recreational rock lobster fishery is 170 tonnes.


