# NOTICE — TOTAL ALLOWABLE CATCH (TAC) OF THE COMMERCIAL BANDED MORWONG FISHERY FOR THE 2021-22 QUOTA PERIOD

I, Guy Barnett, Minister for Primary Industries and Water administering the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* (the Act) pursuant to the powers under section 94 of the Act, for the quota period from 1 March 2021 to 28 February 2022 (inclusive), hereby determine that:

- (a) The Total Allowable Catch for the commercial banded morwong fishery be set at 35,760 kilograms;
- (b) The part of the commercial banded morwong fishery from which the total allowable catch is to be taken is the "TAC area" as defined in the Fisheries (Scalefish) Rules 2015; and,
- (c) The total allowable catch equates to 30 kilograms per quota unit.

Words and expressions used in this notice have the same meaning as they have in the *Living Marine Resources Management Act* 1995 and the *Fisheries (Scalefish) Rules 2015*.
