PUBLISHED NOTICE - DATES OF CLOSING OF THE COMMERCIAL ROCK LOBSTER FISHERY – NORTH EAST CATCH CAPAREA

RULE 10 OF THE FISHERIES (ROCK LOBSTER) RULES 2022

I, Dr Ian Dutton, General Manager – Marine Resources in the Department of Natural Resources and Environment, acting pursuant to a delegation from the Minister for Primary Industries and Water made on 15 November 2022 and acting pursuant to section 20(1) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* ("the Act"), hereby determine under rule 10 of the *Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Rules 2022* (the Rules) that:

- 1) the part of the commercial rock lobster fishery that comprises of the activities of the taking of rock lobster for commercial purposes in "north eastern waters" is closed from 00:01 22 November 2022 to midnight 28 February 2023 inclusive; and
- 2) the setting of a rock lobster pot for commercial purposes in, "the north eastern waters" is closed from 00:01 22 November 2022 to 13:00 28 February 2023 inclusive;

Where:

"north eastern waters" is defined to mean the area of State waters adjacent to the north east coasts of Tasmania, east of the line of longitude 146° 32' 00" East (Point Sorell) on the north coast, and north of the line of latitude 40° 59' 35" South (Eddystone Point) on the east coast.

Words and expressions used in this public notice have the same meaning as in the Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995 and the Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Rules 2022.
