BIOSECURITY REGULATIONS 2022

Public Comment on Statement of Intent to declare *Digitalis* species (foxgloves) as pests under the Biosecurity Regulations 2022

The Department of Natural Resources, and Environment Tasmania (NRE Tas) has prepared a nomination to declare *Digitalis* species (foxgloves) as pests under regulation 4 of the Biosecurity Regulations 2022. This nomination is summarised within a Statement of Intent to declare plants as pests under the Regulations and has been released for public comment and exhibition in accordance with regulation 4(3) of the Biosecurity Regulations 2022.

The Statement of Intent contains descriptions of the nominated plants, Pest Risk Assessment, and Weed Management Biosecurity Program, detailing proposed measures or restrictions in respect of the pests.



GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES
