# LIVING MARINE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1995 PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED ALTERATION TO A MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE

### TASMANIAN SCALEFISH FISHERY

Pursuant to the powers under section 54(1) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* (the Act) that were delegated to the General Manager (Marine Resources) on 31 March 2023 by the Secretary acting pursuant to section 20(2) of the Act, I hereby give notice that:

- a) the management plan for the Tasmanian Scalefish Fishery, in the form of the Fisheries (Scalefish) Rules 2015, is to be altered by the proposed Fisheries (Scalefish) Amendment Rules 2023; and,
- b) a person may submit a written representation in relation to any proposed alteration; and,
- c) particulars of the proposed alteration may be obtained from the:
