This notice prohibits the taking and possession of specially marked rock lobster (as described in this public notice) which are being used for an important research project. The research project will run for approximately three years. The research project is investigating ways to reverse or halt the spread of urchin barrens created by the long spined sea urchin (Centrostephanus rodgersii), on the east coast of Tasmania. Research Area

water mark and the line longitude 148° 20' 11.95" East on the northern side of Grants Point then in a North East direction (45 degrees East) to the intersection of the thirty five metre bathymetric contour and continues south from that point by the thirty five metre bathometric contour to the intersection of the line latitude 40° 15' 26.51" South then due West to the highwater mark.

Restrictions on taking fish in the research area

- 5. A person, in the Elephant Rock Research Area must not –
- (a) take any fish by diving or swimming beneath the surface; or
- (b) set or use a rock lobster pot, rock lobster ring; or
- (c) possess rock lobster marked in the tail fan with two separate and distinct holes that are at least 5 millimetres in diameter or having blue and yellow markings which will be visible within the muscle tissue on the under side of the tail.

Explanatory Note

This order-

Declares Elephant Rock to be a research area for the purposes of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*; and

Imposes certain restrictions on entry, fishing and possession of fish in that research area.
