## Water Management

**WATER MANAGEMENT ACT 1999**  
**ORDER DECLARING A WATER SUPPLY CHANNEL**

*Meander Valley Irrigation District*

**Section 192**

I, DAVID LLEWELLYN, Minister for Primary Industries and Water, being and as the Minister administering the *Water Management Act 1999* ("the Act"), pursuant to S.192 of the Act, hereby declare the following to be a water supply channel for the Meander Valley Irrigation District ("the district"):—

Those parts of the Meander River and its tributaries located within Meander Valley Irrigation District.

(Note: the district was gazetted on 3 September 2007 and is shown on Plans CPR 7893 and 7892 in the Central Plan Register)

Any licence which authorises the taking of water from a watercourse which is declared by this Order to be a water supply channel, continues to have effect, subject to the condition that where a right to be supplied with water for irrigation in the district pursuant to an irrigation right is granted to the licensee under the *Irrigation Clauses Act 1973* with the intention of replacing a water allocation endorsed on the licence, that water allocation is suspended for such period as the licensee holds that irrigation right.

Hydro Tasmania has unconditionally agreed to the Order.

This Order takes effect on the date of its publication in the Gazette and remains in force until it is revoked by declaration published in the Gazette.

#### GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

##### (1) *Duties Amendment Regulations 2008*

These regulations amend the *Duties Regulations 2001* by providing that, for the 2-year period following 29 September 2008, an eligible pensioner does not have to pay duty to transfer the registration of certain vehicles to his or her spouse.

##### (2) *Government Prices Oversight Regulations 2008*

These regulations –

- (a) prescribe the fee payable on the making of a complaint to the Government Prices Oversight Commission under section 39G(c) of the *Government Prices Oversight Act 1995*; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Government Prices Oversight Regulations 1998* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

##### (3) *Meander Valley Irrigation District By-laws 2008*

These by-laws regulate the supply of water for irrigation to owners or occupiers of land in the Meander Valley Irrigation District.

##### (4) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Legal Profession Act 2007*

This proclamation fixes 31 December 2008 as the day on which the provisions of the *Legal Profession Act 2007* that have not already commenced, other than section 661(2), commence.

(5) Proclamation under section 661(1) of the *Legal Profession Act 2007*

This proclamation fixes 31 December 2008 as the day from which the provisions of the *Legal Profession Act 1993*, as in force immediately before that day, are repealed.

(6) *Legal Profession Regulations 2008*

These regulations prescribe a range of matters for the purposes of the *Legal Profession Act 2007*, including—

- (a) matters relating to entitlement to practise; and
- (b) matters relating to professional conduct; and
- (c) practising certificate fees; and
- (d) matters relating to the handling of trust money and the keeping of trust accounts and records; and
- (e) matters relating to the disclosure of costs to clients and the assessment of costs; and
- (f) Solicitors' Trust protocols; and
- (g) forms.

(7) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Legal Profession (Miscellaneous and Consequential Amendments) Act 2007*

This proclamation fixes 31 December 2008 as the day on which sections 5 and 6 of, and Schedule 1 to, the *Legal Profession (Miscellaneous and Consequential Amendments) Act 2007* commence.

(8) *Local Government (Rates and Charges Remissions) Amendment Regulations 2008*

These regulations amend the *Local Government (Rates and Charges Remissions) Regulations 2004* by updating the definition of "eligible person" to include a person who holds a current health care card.

(9) *Monetary Penalties Enforcement Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2008*

These regulations amend the *Monetary Penalties Enforcement Regulations 2008* by prescribing, for the purposes of section 14(a)(ii) of the *Monetary Penalties Enforcement Act 2005*, the penalties for offences specified in infringement notices.

(10) *Plumbers and Gas-fitters Registration Order 2008*

This order amends the *Plumbers and Gas-fitters Registration Act 1951* by updating a reference to the relevant plumbers organisation that is to nominate a person for appointment to the Plumbers and Gas-fitters Registration Board.

(11) *Architects Regulations 2008*

These regulations, which are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Architects Regulations 1997* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*, provide for —

- (a) the election of members of the Board of Architects of Tasmania; and
- (b) proceedings of that Board; and
- (c) the duties of the Registrar of that Board; and
- (d) the registration process for an architect and associated registration fees.

(12) *Criminal Amendment Rules 2008*

These Rules of Court amend the *Criminal Rules 2006* consequentially on the enactment of the *Legal Profession Act 2007*.

(13) *Sale of Hazardous Goods (Hot Water Bottles) Order 2008*

This order restricts the sale of hot water bottles that do not —

- (a) meet minimum standards for thickness and other physical characteristics; and
- (b) pass certain performance tests; and
- (c) carry specified warning messages.

(14) *Sewers and Drains (Cradle Valley Limited Sewerage District) Amendment Order 2008*

This order amends the *Sewers and Drains (Cradle Valley Limited Sewerage District) Order 2007* to correct the description of the declared purpose of the Cradle Valley Limited Sewerage District.
