# DRAFT STATE POLICY ON THE PROTECTION OF AGRICULTURAL LAND 2007

FOLLOWING the first periodic review of the State Policy on the Protection of Agricultural Land 2000 by the Minister for Planning, the Hon Steven Kons, M.P., it was determined that the Policy requires amendment to remain contemporary and effective in fostering sustainable agriculture in Tasmania.

On 21 December 2007 the Premier, the Hon Paul Lennon M.P., directed the Resource Planning and Development Commission (Commission) to advise whether the proposed Policy amendments constituted a significant change to the current Policy.

The Commission hereby gives notice in accordance with section 15A(4) of the *State Policies and Projects Act 1993* that the Commission resolved on 21 January 2008 to advise the Premier that the proposed amendments to the Policy constitute a significant change to the current Policy.

Treasury and Finance Hobart, 13 February 2008

Fee Units Act 1997

THE Fee Units Act 1997 provides for automatic changes in Government fees and charges in accordance with movements in the Hobart Consumer Price Index (CPI). The Fee Units Act also provides for adjustments to be made on the basis of factors other than movements in the CPI through a fee unit adjustment factor.

In accordance with section 5 of the Fee Units Act, the value of a fee of a fee unit is increased by the CPI increase and for 2008-09 will be \$1.28.

In accordance with section 5(4) of the Fee Units Act, I have determined the fee unit adjustment factor for 2008-09 to be zero.

In determining the value of the fee unit adjustment factor, it was considered that there were no special factors that would warrant the discounting of the increase in the value of a fee unit in 2008-09 below the CPI increase.

PUBLIC NOTICE—DATES OF CLOSED SEASON FOR PART OF THE SCALEFISH FISHERY

I, CRAIG MIDGELEY, Manager (Licensing and Administration), acting under Rule 12 of the Fisheries Rules 1999 and Rule 9 of the Fisheries (Scalefish) Rules 2004 and in accordance with delegated authority under section 20 (1) of the Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995 hereby determine that the dates of the closed season for the fishery for banded morwong that involves the take or possession of banded morwong (Cheilodactylus spectabilis) in State waters are from 1 March 2008 to 30 April 2008, inclusive.

Information

This notice closes the fishery for banded morwong in all State waters. No commercial or recreational fisher may take, or be in possession of, any banded morwong in State waters between 1 March 2008 and 30 April 2008. This includes the possession of banded morwong in wells or fish caufs. The closure is necessary to:—

- protect spawning banded morwong during a period of high vulnerability; and
- prevent incidental mortality of banded morwong held in captivity during the spawning period when they are particularly sensitive to stress.
