A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Parliament of Tasmania be prorogued, I, The Honourable WILLIAM JOHN ELLIS COX, Companion of the Order of Australia, Governor in and over the State of Tasmania and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, exercising the power and authority vested in me by the *Constitution Act 1934*, hereby prorogue the Parliament effective from 6.00 p.m. this day.

And I hereby fix 2.30 p.m. on Tuesday 4 March 2008 in the Houses of Parliament situated in the City of Hobart in Tasmania as the time and place for the next Session of Parliament.
