The purpose of the Code is to provide guidance to responsible persons at underground mines and associated facilities on how to meet their general duty of care responsibilities under the Workplace Health and Safety Act 1995 through and in relation to:

- · Safety management systems;
- · Risk management;
- · Safety requirements for conveyors; and
- Guidance on the application of exposure standards for atmospheric contaminants.

Industry is not required to comply with the Code, but may be asked to demonstrate that the system chosen is equal to, or better than, the approved Code of Practice.

GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Animal Welfare Amendment Regulations 2008

These regulations amend the Animal Welfare Regulations 1993 by prescribing further requirements for cages used to keep laying fowls.

(2) Electricity Supply Industry (Tariff Customers) Regulations 2008

These regulations -

- (a) set out certain conditions relating to the sale and supply of electricity to tariff customers; and
- (b) establish the contractual relationship between a tariff customer, an electricity retailer and a distributor of electricity; and
- (c) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Electricity Supply Industry (Tariff Customers) Regulations 1998* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(3) Sentencing Regulations 2008

These regulations -

- (a) prescribe 30 June 2009 as the cut-off date for the making of drug treatment orders under Part 3A of the Sentencing Act 1997; and
- (b) prescribe the cost of a warrant of commitment and the amount of a prescribed unit for the purposes of that Act; and
- (c) prescribe a form for the purposes of section 89(1)(a) of that Act; and
- (d) are made consequentially on the repeal of the Sentencing Regulations 1998 under section 11 of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1992.

(4) Taxi Industry Amendment (Security Cameras) Regulations 2008

These regulations amend the *Taxi Industry Regulations 1996* by providing that a VerifEye Taxicam TSCS Mk IV is a security camera system for the purposes of Part 5A of those regulations.
