Local Government (General) Amendment (Councillor Allowances) Regulations 2008

These regulations amend the *Local Government (General) Regulations 2005* by –

- (a) updating the allowances payable to councillors, deputy mayors and mayors with effect from 1 November 2008; and
- (b) changing the index used to ascertain the inflationary factor for the calculation of subsequent annual adjustments to those allowances.
