#### PUBLIC NOTICE - DATES OF CLOSED SEASON FOR PART OF THE SCALEFISH FISHERY

I, Robert Gott, Director Marine Resources, acting as per delegated authority contained in Section 20(1) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*, do under Rule 12 of the *Fisheries Rules 1999*, and Rule 9 of the *Fisheries (Scalefish) Rules 2004* hereby determine: the dates of the closed season for that part of the scalefish fishery that involves: the take or possession of all squid species including southern calamari (*Sepioteuthis australis*) by any person in the following east coast Tasmanian waters:

- Great Oyster Bay, as defined in schedule 2 of the *Fisheries (Scalefish) Rules 2004*; and
- all east coast Tasmanian waters between an imaginary straight line running due east through Lemon Rock (42°11'44" South [GDA 94]) to the outer limit of State waters and an imaginary straight line running due east from the northern end of Marion Beach (42°46'06" South [GDA 94]) to the outer limit of State waters.

Closed season from: 1 October 2008 to 14 December 2008 inclusive.

This order retrospectively amends the *Government Prices Oversight (MAIB Premiums) Order 2006* by extending the concession in MAIB premiums currently available to pensioners to the holders of certain health care cards.

These regulations amend the *Inland Fisheries (Recreational Fishing) Regulations 1999* by –

- (a) prescribing new size and bag limits for fish taken from certain waters; and
- (b) effecting minor statute law revision.
