#### GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

##### (1) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Taxi and Luxury Hire Car Industries Act 2008*

This proclamation fixes 24 September 2008 as the day on which the provisions of the *Taxi and Luxury Hire Car Industries Act 2008* commence.

##### (2) *Luxury Hire Car Industry Regulations 2008*

These regulations prescribe for the purpose of the *Taxi and Luxury Hire Car Industries Act 2008* –

- (a) the licensing, operating and equipment requirements of luxury hire cars; and
- (b) the fees payable in respect of the licensing of luxury hire cars and other related matters; and
- (c) other miscellaneous matters.

##### (3) *Taxi Industry Regulations 2008*

These regulations prescribe for the purpose of the *Taxi and Luxury Hire Car Industries Act 2008* –

- (a) the licensing, operating and equipment requirements of taxis; and
- (b) the appointment and duties of authorised meter adjusters; and
- (c) the fares, surcharges and tariffs to be charged by taxis; and
- (d) the fees payable in respect of the licensing of taxis and other related matters; and
- (e) other miscellaneous matters.

##### (4) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Taxi and Luxury Hire Car Industries (Consequential Amendments) Act 2008*

This proclamation fixes 24 September 2008 as the day on which the provisions of the *Taxi and Luxury Hire Car Industries (Consequential Amendments) Act 2008* commence.

(5) *Government Prices Oversight (MAIB Premiums) Amendment Order (No. 3) 2008*

This order amends the *Government Prices Oversight (MAIB Premiums) Order 2006* consequential on the enactment of the *Taxi and Luxury Hire Car Industries Act 2008*.

(6) *Justices (Review) Amendment Rules 2008*

These Rules of Court amend the *Justices (Review) Rules 2004* by –

- (a) providing for consent orders and notices of discontinuance; and
- (b) making minor miscellaneous amendments.
