WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT 1995

I HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that, pursuant to section 22 (5) of the *Workplace Health and Safety Act 1995*, I have approved the Code of Practice – Induction for Construction Work.

The purpose of the Code is to protect persons from the hazards associated with construction work. The Code provides guidance to persons working in general and residential construction sectors on the types of induction training that may be needed to provide construction workers with an awareness and understanding of common hazards on construction sites and how they should be managed.

Industry is not required to comply with the Code, but may be asked to demonstrate that the system chosen is equal to, or better than, the approved Code of Practice.

LIVING MARINE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1995

Fisheries (Commercial Dive) Rules 2005- RULE 14 **Determination of Minimum Size Limits Applying to the Commercial Dive Fishery**

I, GRANT PULLEN, Manager Wild Fisheries, acting under Rule 14 of the *Fisheries (Commercial Dive Rules) 2005*, and delegated authority under Section 20(1) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* hereby:—

1. Determine that the minimum size limit from 1 September 2009 for sea urchins (*heliocidaris erythrogramma*) is 60 mm. The holder of a fishing licence (commercial dive) may therefore not possess sea urchins (*heliocidaris erythrogramma*) that have a maximum test diameter (casing inside spines) which is less than 60 mm from that date.

2. Determine that the minimum size limit from 1 September 2009 for periwinkles (*Genus Turbo*) is 40 mm. The holder of a fishing licence (commercial dive) may therefore not possess periwinkles (*Genus Turbo*) that are less than 40 mm at their longest dimension from that date.

Fisheries (Shellfish) Rules 2007, Rule 7

PUBLIC NOTICE – SETTING OF TOTAL ALLOWABLE CATCH (TAC), DETERMINING THE PARTS AND PORTIONS FROM WHICH THE TAC IS TO BE TAKEN FOR THE COMMERCIAL SHELLFISH FISHERY.

I, DAVID LLEWELLYN, the Minister administering the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*, pursuant to section 94 of that Act, and to the *Fisheries (Shellfish) Rules 2007, Rule 7* hereby for the 2009/2010 quota period of the commercial shellfish fishery commencing 1 September 2009 and finishing 31 August 2010 inclusive:

1. Set the total allowable catch for the commercial shellfish fishery as: 37,860 kilograms of *Venerupis* clams; 12,690 kilograms of *Katelysia* cockles; and 41,000 dozen native oysters; and,

2. Determine that the parts of the commercial shellfish fishery from which the total allowable catch is to be taken are: the Georges Bay South Clam Zone; Georges Bay North Clam Zone; Ansons Bay Cockle Zone; and Georges Bay; and,

3. Determine that the portion of total allowable catch to be taken from each part of the commercial shellfish fishery is as follows;

Georges Bay South Clam Zone – 9,360 kilograms of *Venerupis* clams;

Georges Bay North Clam Zone – 28,500 kilograms of *Venerupis* clams;

Ansons Bay Cockle Zone – 12,690 kilograms of *Katelysia* cockles; and,

Georges Bay – 41,000 dozen native oysters.

Words and expressions used in this Public Notice have the same meaning as they have in the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* and the *Fisheries (Shellfish) Rules 2007*.

PARLIAMENTARY STANDING COMMITTEE ON SUBORDINATE LEGISLATION
