GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Inland Fisheries (Commercial Nets and Fees) Regulations 2009

These regulations-

9 DECEMBER 2009

- (a) regulate the taking and possession of fish, and the use of equipment, by holders of commercial freshwater fishing licences; and
- (b) prescribe fees for the purposes of the Inland Fisheries Act 1995; and
- (c) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Inland Fisheries (Commercial Nets and Fees) Regulations 1999* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(2) Inland Fisheries (Recreational Fishing) Regulations 2009

These regulations—

- (a) provide for a range of matters to regulate the recreational fishery in inland waters; and
- (b) prescribe fees and infringement notice offences for that fishery; and
- (c) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Inland Fisheries (Recreational Fishing) Regulations 1999* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992.*

(3) Proclamation under section 2 of the Land Use Planning and Approvals Amendment (State and Regional Strategies) Act 2009

This proclamation fixes 1 January 2010 as the day on which the provisions of the Land Use Planning and Approvals Amendment (State and Regional Strategies) Act 2009 commence.

(4) Land Use Planning and Approvals Amendment Regulations 2009

These regulations amend the Land Use Planning and Approvals Regulations 2004 to include requirements in relation to notification of, and fees in relation to, projects of regional significance.

(5) Fisheries (General and Fees) Amendment Regulations 2009

These regulations amend the *Fisheries (General and Fees) Regulations 2006* by prescribing fees for the renewal, transfer and variation of a fishing licence (octopus).

(6) Fisheries (General and Fees) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2009

These regulations amend the Fisheries (General and Fees) Regulations 2006 by -

- (a) amending the definitions of "Bass Strait area", "mother boat", "northern area" and "northern blacklip area"; and
- (b) updating a legislative reference.

(7) Proclamation under section 21(1) of the Nature Conservation Act 2002

This proclamation declares that the River Derwent Conservation Area ceases to be reserved land in the class of conservation area.

(8) Proclamation under sections 11(2) and 21(1) of the Nature Conservation Act 2002

This proclamation revokes the existing marine nature reserves at Tinderbox and Nine Pin Point and creates a new Tinderbox Marine Nature Reserve and a new Ninepin Point Marine Nature Reserve.

(9) Proclamation under sections 11(2) and 19(2) of the Nature Conservation Act 2002

This proclamation, under the Nature Conservation Act 2002-

(a) declares certain areas of Crown land to be reserved land in the class of conservation area; and

- (b) re-names certain conservation areas; and
- (c) extends the South Arm Marine Conservation Area.

(10) Passenger Transport Amendment (Community Transport) Regulations 2009

These regulations amend the *Passenger Transport Regulations 2000* by extending, until 1 January 2011, the period of the temporary exemption from registration under the *Passenger Transport Act 1997* for small passenger vehicles that are used to provide community transport services.

(11) Poisons Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2009

These regulations amend the Poisons Regulations 2008-

- (a) consequent on the enactment of the Education and Training (Miscellaneous and Consequential Amendments) Act 2008, the Education and Training (Tasmanian Academy) Act 2008 and the Education and Training (Tasmanian Polytechnic) Act 2008; and
- (b) by prescribing persons who may administer medicinal poisons and potent, restricted and narcotic substances; and
- (c) by prescribing the conditions on which those poisons and substances may be administered.

(12) Proclamation under section 2 of the Police Miscellaneous Amendments Act (No. 2) 2009

This proclamation fixes 9 December 2009 as the day on which section 10 of the *Police Miscellaneous Amendments Act (No. 2)* 2009 commences.

(13) Proclamation under section 2 of the Police Offences Amendment (Clamping) Act 2009

This proclamation fixes 11 December 2009 as the day on which the Police Offences Amendment (Clamping) Act 2009 commences.

(14) Police Offences Amendment (Clamping) Regulations 2009

These regulations amend the *Police Offences Regulations 2007* by prescribing \$600 as the amount of the special compulsory penalty for section 37MA of the *Police Offences Act 1935*.

(15) Police Offences (Confiscation of Vehicles) Regulations 2009

These regulations prescribe speeding in excess of 45km/h above the speed limit and a second or subsequent charge of driving while disqualified as offences for the purposes of the confiscation of vehicles under Part IVA of the *Police Offences Act 1935*.

(16) Police Offences (Liquor) Amendment Regulations 2009

These regulations amend the *Police Offences (Liquor) Regulations 2005* by prescribing the penalty payable in respect of a liquor infringement notice issued for an offence against section 26 of the *Police Offences Act 1935* relating to the responsible supply of liquor to youths.

(17) Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Amendment (Community Transport) Regulations 2009

These regulations amend the *Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2000* by extending, until 1 January 2011, the period of the temporary exemption for drivers of small passenger vehicles providing community transport services from the requirement to hold an ancillary certificate under the *Vehicle and Traffic Act 1999*.
