PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency THE HONOURABLE EWAN CHARLES CRAWFORD, Administrator of the State of Tasmania and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by Letters Patent constituting the Office of Governor of the State of Tasmania and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia made at Hobart on 21 November 2005 under the Public Seal of the said State it is provided that in the event of the Governor being for any reason unable to act as Governor (not having appointed a deputy under Clause XI of the said Letters Patent) and of there being no Lieutenant-Governor, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Tasmania shall be Administrator

AND WHEREAS the Governor of the said State, THE HONOURABLE PETER GEORGE UNDERWOOD, Officer of the Order of Australia, is unable to act as Governor for the period commencing at 9.00 am on 17 February 2009 and ending at 5.00 pm on 20 February 2009 and has not appointed a Deputy Governor

AND WHEREAS there is no Lieutenant-Governor of the said State

AND WHEREAS by Letters Patent dated 8 April 2008 under the Public Seal of the said State THE HONOURABLE EWAN CHARLES CRAWFORD was appointed as the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Tasmania with effect from 24 April 2008.

NOW THEREFORE I, THE HONOURABLE EWAN CHARLES CRAWFORD, Administrator of the said State having taken the Oaths directed by law to be taken by the Administrator in the manner prescribed do hereby notify and declare that while the Governor of Tasmania is unable to act as Governor for the abovementioned period or until he is able to act, and while there is no Deputy Governor and no Lieutenant-Governor, I shall administer the government of the said State with all and singular the powers and functions of the Governor according to such Laws as are now or shall hereafter be in force in the said State.
