NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF STATUTORY RULES

In accordance with the provisions of the *Rules Publication Act 1953*, notice is given of the making of the following statutory rules:—

GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *State Service (Restructuring) Order 2009*

This order effects a restructuring of the State Service by –

- (a) amalgamating parts of a Government department with other Government departments; and
- (b) changing the name of two Government departments; and
- (c) abolishing a Government department.

(2) *State Service (Agencies and Heads of Agencies) Order 2009*

This order repeals Schedule 1 to the *State Service Act 2000*, which specifies the Agencies and Heads of Agencies, and substitutes a new Schedule 1.

(3) *Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 2) 2009*

This order –

- (a) assigns to Ministers of the Crown the administration of enactments; and
- (b) specifies which Government department or State authority is responsible to which Minister in relation to the administration of those enactments.
