#### Fisheries (Biosecurity) Order (No. 3) 2009

I, DAVID LLEWELLYN, Minister for Primary Industries and Water, make the following Order under Section 270 of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* in relation to issuing directions aimed at preventing the introduction or spread in State waters of a harmful disease.

#### Short title

**1.**—This Order may be cited as the *Fisheries (Biosecurity)* Order (No. 3) 2009.

#### Specification

**2.**—This Order is made in respect of the disease *Abalone Viral Ganglioneuritis* and is aimed at preventing the introduction or spread of the disease in State waters or any other jurisdiction.

#### **Directions Issued**

**3.**—That no part of any abalone (*Genus Haliotis*) may be used as bait in State waters, on and from the date this order is published in the *Tasmanian Government Gazette* for a period of 12 months.

#### Interpretation

**4.**—Expressions in this Order have the same meaning as in the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995.*
