Whereas by a Proclamation under the hand of His Excellency The Honourable Peter George Underwood, Companion of the Order of Australia, Governor in and over the State of Tasmania and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, dated 21 April 2010, a session of Our Parliament of Tasmania was summoned to be held for the despatch of business on 4 May 2010

AND WHEREAS it is expedient for the session of the Parliament of Our State to be opened by Commissioners:

WE do by these Our Letters Patent appoint you the said GREGORY RAYMOND HALL, MICHAEL ANTHONY AIRD and DOUGLAS JOHN PARKINSON, or any two of you, to be Commissioners with full power in Our name in the name of Our Governor of Our said State to do things which are to be done on Their part in this Parliament

AND further by these presents we command that all and every of the members of Our Legislative Council and House of Assembly, and all others whom they concern, meet in Our said Parliament there to diligently attend to the business thereof.

In testimony whereof We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of Our said State to be hereunto affixed.
