1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the *Fisheries (Abalone Management Plan) Order (No. 2) 2010*.

2. Commencement

This Order takes effect on the day on which it is published in the *Gazette*.

3. Rule 50 of Fisheries (Abalone) Rules 2009 changed

Rule 50 of the *Fisheries (Abalone) Rules 2009** is changed by omitting from subrule (9)(b)(i) “the quota period in which the abalone were taken” and substituting “the abalone”.

This Order changes the management plan for the abalone fishery so as to provide that a payment to the Crown in respect of excess abalone is to be determined according to the last beach price generally rather than the last beach price for the quota period in which they were taken.

(2) *Gas Pipelines (Transmission Pipeline) Amendment Order 2010*

This order amends the *Gas Pipelines (Transmission Pipeline) Order 2001* by providing that the pipeline for the delivery of gas to the BOC Liquefied Natural Gas plant at Westbury is to be treated as a transmission pipeline for the purposes of the *Gas Pipelines Act 2000*.
