DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES (SAFE HANDLING) ACT 2005

NOTICE OF CLASSIFICATION OF A MAJOR HAZARD FACILITY

Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995

Fisheries (Biosecurity) Order (No. 2) 2010

I MAKE the following Order under section 270 of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* issuing directions aimed at preventing the introduction into State waters of a harmful disease.

Short title

1. - This Order may be cited as the Fisheries (Biosecurity) Order (No. 2) 2010.

Specification

2. - This Order is made in respect of the disease *Abalone Viral Ganglioneuritis* and is aimed at preventing the introduction of the disease into State waters.

Directions Issued

- 3. (1) That, unless otherwise authorised under Rule 62 of the *Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Rules 2006*, all abalone and rock lobster taken in State waters must be landed in Tasmania.
 - (2) That, unless otherwise authorised in writing by the Secretary, no rock lobster taken, other than under the authority of a Tasmanian commercial fishing licence, may be possessed in State waters north of the line of latitude 39° 30' South in a vessel other than a trading vessel or a USL/NSCV code class 2 vessel.
 - (3) That all abalone taken under the authority of a Tasmanian commercial fishing licence (abalone dive) from State waters adjacent to King Island bounded by the line of latitude 40° 20′ 00" South in the south, the line of longitude 143° 30′ 00" East in the west, the line of latitude 39° 30′ 00" South in the north and the line of longitude 144° 30′ 00" East in the east must either:
 - a) be landed on King Island; or
 - b) be landed at the port of Stanley in north-west Tasmania; in which case, all abalone taken and possessed under the authority of a fishing licence (abalone dive), possessed by Masters of a fishing vessel, or possessed by holders of a fish processing licence authorised to process abalone must be taken, possessed and processed in compliance with the <u>Specifications for Commercial Abalone Fishing or Processing in Defined Waters</u> as provided for under Section 270 (3) (d) of the <u>Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995</u>.

This Order takes effect on 1 August 2010 and remains in force for a period of 12 months.

Interpretation

- 4. Expressions in this Order have the same meaning as in the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* and the *Fisheries (Abalone) Rules 2009*.
- "USL" in this Order means Uniform Shipping Laws.
- "NSCV" in this Order means National Standard for Commercial Vessels.

This order renews for a period of 6 months the *Water and Sewerage Industry Exemption Order 2009*, which exempts all persons, except for the Regional Corporations, from sections 20(2) and 30 of the *Water and Sewerage Industry Act 2008*.
