Public Notice – Dates of the Closed Season for Part of the Commercial Scalefish Fishery

I, ROBERT GOTT, Director (Marine Resources), acting under Rule 9 of the *Fisheries (Scalefish) Rules 2004* and in accordance with delegated authority under section 20(1) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* hereby determine that the dates of the closed season for the commercial fishery for garfish that involves the take or possession for commercial purposes of all species of garfish (family *Hemiramphidae*) in State waters, for northern and southern waters are as follows:

Southern Waters closed between:

- 15 November 2010 and 14 December 2010
- 15 November 2011 and 14 December 2011
- 15 November 2012 and 14 December 2012

Northern Waters closed between:

- 15 January 2011 and 14 February 2011
- 15 January 2012 and 14 February 2012
- 15 January 2013 and 14 February 2013

Northern and southern waters are delineated by a line following the north coast of Tasmania, joined and bounded in the west by a line of latitude through Cape Grim and in the east by a line of latitude through Cape Naturaliste. All waters to the north of this line are Northern Waters and all waters to the south of this line are Southern Waters.

GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Crown Lands (Shack Sites) Amendment Regulations 2010

These regulations amend the Crown Lands (Shack Sites) Regulations 2002 by prescribing, for the purposes of section 17 of the Crown Lands (Shack Sites) Act 1997, the method for determining the rental for replacement leases of shack sites.

(2) Environmental Management and Pollution Control (Environmental Infringement Notices)
Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2010

These regulations amend the Environmental Management and Pollution Control (Environmental Infringement Notices)
Regulations 2006 by –

- (a) prescribing offences under the *Environmental Management and Pollution Control (Underground Petroleum Storage Systems) Regulations 2010* for which infringement notices may be issued and the penalties payable for those infringement notice offences; and
- (b) revising existing offences, and adding new offences, under the *Environmental Management and Pollution Control* (Miscellaneous Noise) Regulations 2004 for which infringement notices may be issued and the penalties payable for those infringement notice offences.
 - (3) Environmental Management and Pollution Control (Waste Management) Regulations 2010

These regulations -

- (a) make provision in respect of
 - (i) the management of controlled waste and general waste; and
 - (ii) miscellaneous matters relating to waste; and
- (b) rescind the *Environmental Management and Pollution Control (Waste Management) Regulations 2000* and subsequent amendments to those regulations.
 - (4) Road Safety (Alcohol and Drugs) (Approval of Instruments) Notice 2010

This notice approves the device under the brand name of "ENVITEC", which bears on its body the name "ENVITEC ALCOQUANT", for use in the carrying out of breath tests under the Road Safety (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1970.
