GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Animal Health (Apiaries) Regulations 2011

These regulations-

- (a) provide for the prevention and control of disease within the apiary industry; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Animal Health (Apiaries) Regulations 2001* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.
 - (2) Fisheries (General and Fees) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2011

These regulations amend the *Fisheries (General and Fees) Regulations 2006* by providing for the determination of the fee that is to be paid under clause 5.2 of the 1994 abalone deed of agreement during the next 2 terms of that deed of agreement if it is not terminated.

(3) Mineral Resources Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2011

These regulations amend the Mineral Resources Regulations 2006 by increasing –

- (a) the prescribed rates of royalty payable by lessees and licensees in respect of minerals; and
- (b) the fees specified in Schedule 2 to those regulations; and
- (c) the rent payable for land over which licences and leases are granted.
 - (4) Proclamation under section 11(2) of the Nature Conservation Act 2002

This proclamation, under the Nature Conservation Act 2002 –

- (a) declares certain areas of Crown land to be reserved land in the class of nature reserve; and
- (b) in doing so, creates certain new nature reserves and extends certain existing nature reserves.

(5) Proclamation under section 2 of the Residential Tenancy Amendment Act 2011

This proclamation fixes 1 January 2012 as the day on which the provisions of the Residential Tenancy Amendment Act 2011 commence.

(6) Residential Tenancy Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2011

These regulations amend the Residential Tenancy Regulations 2005 by -

- (a) prescribing the failure to pay a security deposit to specified persons as an infringement notice offence; and
- (b) effecting minor statute law revision.
 - (7) Proclamation under section 52A of the Roads and Jetties Act 1935

This proclamation amends the proclamation notified in the Gazette on 24 November 1993 as Statutory Rules 1993, No. 236 by –

- (a) omitting a reference to an out-of-date Plan in Schedule 1 to that proclamation and substituting a reference to a new Plan; and
- (b) revising the places of access to the part of the East Tamar Highway declared by that proclamation to be a limited access road.
 - (8) Teachers Registration Regulations 2011

These regulations -

- (a) prescribe certain fees that are payable under the Teachers Registration Act 2000; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Teachers Registration Regulations 2001* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.
 - (9) Water Management Amendment Regulations 2011

These regulations amend the Water Management Regulations 2009 by –

- (a) revising the fee rebate provisions with the result that an administrative fee rebate is available to all licensees under the *Water Management Act 1999* and not merely eligible pensioners; and
- (b) omitting a redundant fee; and
- (c) revising the annual fees that Regional Corporations are to pay for water allocations.
