GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Administrative Arrangements (No. 2) Amendment Order (No. 2) 2011

This order amends the *Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 2) 2011* so as to make the Department of Premier and Cabinet the department responsible to the Minister for Veterans' Affairs in relation to the administration of the *Anzac Day Observance Act 1929*.

(2) Bills of Sale Regulations 2011

These regulations prescribe -

- (a) forms for the purposes of the Bills of Sale Act 1900; and
- (b) fees payable for the purposes of section 46 of that Act.
 - (3) Crime (Confiscation of Profits) Amendment Regulations 2011

These regulations amend the Crime (Confiscation of Profits) Regulations 2004 by prescribing additional purposes for which the funds in the Crime (Confiscation of Profits) Account may be made available.

(4) Proclamation under section 2 of the Crown Lands (Validation of Fees) Act 2011

This proclamation fixes 28 December 2011 as the day on which the Crown Lands (Validation of Fees) Act 2011 commences.

(5) Local Government (General) Amendment Regulations 2011

These regulations amend the Local Government (General) Regulations 2005, consequent on the enactment of the Education and Care Services Education and Care Services National Law (Application) Act 2011, to provide that a council under section 176 of the Local Government Act 1993 may acquire land for the purposes of certain education and care service premises within the meaning of the Education and Care Services National Law, as well as for the purposes of a child care centre within the meaning of the Child Care Act 2001.

(6) Proclamation under section 2 of the Motor Vehicle Traders Act 2011

This proclamation fixes 31 December 2011 as the day on which section 64(1) of, and Schedule 1 to, the *Motor Vehicle Traders Act* 2011 commence.

(7) Proclamation under section 2 of the Occupational Licensing National Law Act 2011

This proclamation commences certain provisions of the *Occupational Licensing National Law Act 2011* on 4 January 2012 so that parts of the Occupational Licensing National Law apply as a law of this jurisdiction from that date. The provisions commenced confer functions on the Ministerial Council and establish the National Occupational Licensing Authority.

(8) Proclamation under section 2(2) of the Personal Property Securities (Commonwealth Powers) Act 2010

This proclamation fixes 30 January 2012 as the day on which sections 8(2) and (3) of the *Personal Property Securities* (Commonwealth Powers) Act 2010 commence.

(9) Proclamation under section 2(2) of the Personal Property Securities (National Uniform Legislation) Implementation Act 2011

This proclamation fixes 30 January 2012 as the day on which the provisions of the Personal Property Securities (National Uniform Legislation) Implementation Act 2011, except sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 7, commence.

(10) Poisons Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2011

These regulations amend the Poisons Regulations 2008, consequent on the enactment of the Education and Care Services National Law (Tasmania), to allow certain persons providing education and care to a child attending an education and care service to administer, or make available for self-administration, to the child a medicinal poison, potent substance, restricted substance or narcotic substance in certain circumstances.

(11) Poisons List Amendment Order (No. 3) 2011

This order amends the *Poisons List Order 2001* by incorporating changes recommended by the National Drugs and Poisons Schedule Committee in the Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Medicines and Poisons No. 2, Amendments Nos. 2 and 3.

(12) Public Health (General) Rescission Regulations 2011

These regulations rescind the Public Health (General) Regulations 2005 and the Public Health (General) Amendment Regulations 2006.

(13) Public Health (Infringement Notices) Amendment Regulations 2011

These regulations amend the Public Health (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2008 by -

- (a) prescribing certain offences under the *Public Health Act 1997* as offences for which infringement notices may be issued; and
- (b) prescribing the penalties for those infringement notice offences; and
- (c) updating certain legislative references.

(14) Public Health (Tobacco Seller's Licence) Amendment Regulations 2011

These regulations amend the Public Health (Tobacco Seller's Licence) Regulations 2009 by -

- (a) increasing certain fees that are payable under the Public Health Act 1997 in respect of tobacco sellers' licences; and
- (b) providing for the expiry on 1 March 2012 of regulation 4(3) consequent on the repeal of section 74K of that Act by the *Public Health Amendment Act 2011*.

(15) Luxury Hire Car Industry Amendment (Fees) Regulations 2011

These regulations amend the *Luxury Hire Car Industry Regulations 2008* by reducing the annual administration fee payable for a luxury hire car licence under the *Taxi and Luxury Hire Car Industries Act 2008*.

(16) Taxi Industry Amendment (Fees) Regulations 2011

These regulations amend the *Taxi Industry Regulations 2008* by reducing the annual administration fee that is payable in respect of a taxi licence under the *Taxi and Luxury Hire Car Industries Act 2008*.
