GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Proclamation under section 2 of the Relationships Amendment (Recognition of Registered Relationships) Act 2010

This proclamation fixes 1 April 2011 as the day on which the Relationships Amendment (Recognition of Registered Relationships) Act 2010 commences.

(2) Relationships Amendment Regulations 2011

These regulations amend the *Relationships Regulations 2003* by providing corresponding laws and classes of relationships for the purpose of section 65A of the *Relationships Act 2003*.

VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC ACT 1999

Section 57
