EXEMPTION RENEWED

THE following application to renew an exemption from the provisions of the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1998* (Tas) (the Act) has been granted:

1. Rio Tinto Alcan – (09/129) – Application to renew an exemption granted under section 57 of the Act for a period of three years.

This exemption renewal has been granted to enable Rio Tinto Alcan at Bell Bay to continue an advertising campaign 'Jobs for girls' campaign that targets female applicants to apply for Process Operator positions and escalate female applicants on the waiting list during the recruitment process.

The exemption has been granted on the condition that Rio Tinto Alcan continues to undertake community education and/ or corporate anti-discrimination training on a yearly basis for its members, officers, employees and agents and that it provide an annual report to me on actions relying on the exemption that are taken in pursuance of the campaign and outcomes of the campaign in terms of gender equity.

A person may apply to the Anti-Discrimination Tribunal for a review of the Commissioner's decision within 28 days from the date of this notice being published.

- (c) TO cut away remove and keep clear of the electricity infrastructure all trees and other obstructions or erections of any nature whatsoever which may at any time:
 - (i) overhang, encroach upon or be in or on the servient land; or
 - (ii) which may in the opinion of Transend endanger or interfere with the proper operation of the electricity infrastructure.
- (d) TO enter the servient land for all or any of the above purposes and to cross the remainder of the land with any and all necessary plant, equipment, machinery and vehicles for the purpose of access and egress to and from the servient land, and where reasonably practicable, in consultation with the registered proprietor/s (except when urgent or emergency repair work is needed).

- (i) erect any buildings; or
