(2) Misuse of Drugs Order 2012

This order amends the *Misuse of Drugs Act 2001* by adding certain substances to the lists of controlled drugs and controlled precursors.

(3) Relationships Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2012

These regulations amend the *Relationships Regulations 2003* by increasing certain prescribed fees that are payable under the *Relationships Act 2003*.
