GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT of THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Gas Infrastructure (Planning Permit Exemption) Regulations 2013*

These regulations –

- (a) prescribe the gas infrastructure development work that, providing it meets certain criteria prescribed in these regulations, does not require a planning permit under the *Land Use Planning and Approvals Act 1993*; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Gas Infrastructure (Planning Permit Exemption) Regulations 2003* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.
