GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Building Amendment Regulations 2013*

These regulations amend the *Building Regulations 2004* to substitute a reference to TasTAFE for a reference to the Tasmanian Polytechnic consequent on the repeal of the *Education and Training (Tasmanian Polytechnic) Act 2008* by the *Training and Workforce Development (Repeals and Consequential Amendments) Act 2013* and the creation of TasTAFE by the *Training and Workforce Development Act 2013*.

(2) *Collections for Charities (Approved Organisations) Amendment Order 2013*

This order amends the *Collections for Charities (Approved Organisations) Order 2002* to remove a reference to the Tasmanian Polytechnic and to substitute a reference to TasTAFE for a reference to the Tasmanian Skills Institute, consequent on –

- (a) the repeal of the *Education and Training (Tasmanian Polytechnic) Act 2008* and the *Education and Training (Tasmanian Skills Institute) Act 2008* by the *Training and Workforce Development (Repeals and Consequential Amendments) Act 2013*; and
- (b) the creation of TasTAFE by the *Training and Workforce Development Act 2013*.

(3) Proclamation under section 227(1)(d) of the *Duties Act 2001*

This proclamation amends the proclamation notified in the *Gazette* as Statutory Rules 2001, No. 76 to remove a reference to Skills Tasmania consequent on the repeal of the *Vocational Education and Training Act 1994* by the *Training and Workforce Development (Repeals and Consequential Amendments) Act 2013*.

(4) *Health (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2013*

These regulations amend the *Health (Fees) Regulations 2007* by increasing certain fees payable by or on behalf of non-nursing-home-type patients for hospital services provided to those persons in public hospitals.

(5) *Plumbing Amendment Regulations 2013*

These regulations amend the *Plumbing Regulations 2004* to substitute a reference to TasTAFE for a reference to the Tasmanian Polytechnic consequent on the repeal of the *Education and Training (Tasmanian Polytechnic) Act 2008* by the *Training and Workforce Development (Repeals and Consequential Amendments) Act 2013* and the creation of TasTAFE by the *Training and Workforce Development Act 2013*.

(6) *Poisons Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2013*

These regulations amend the *Poisons Regulations 2008* to substitute references to TasTAFE for references to the Tasmanian Polytechnic consequent on the repeal of the *Education and Training (Tasmanian Polytechnic) Act 2008* by the *Training and Workforce Development (Repeals and Consequential Amendments) Act 2013* and the creation of TasTAFE by the *Training and Workforce Development Act 2013*.

(7) *Radiation Protection Amendment Regulations 2013*

These regulations amend the *Radiation Protection Regulations 2006* to substitute a reference to TasTAFE for a reference to the Tasmanian Polytechnic consequent on the repeal of the *Education and Training (Tasmanian Polytechnic) Act 2008* by the *Training and Workforce Development (Repeals and Consequential Amendments) Act 2013* and the creation of TasTAFE by the *Training and Workforce Development Act 2013*.

(8) *Teachers Registration Amendment Regulations 2013*

These regulations amend the *Teachers Registration Regulations 2011* to change terminology relating to registration consequent on the amendment of the *Teachers Registration Act 2000* by the *Training and Workforce Development (Repeals and Consequential Amendments) Act 2013*.
