### GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Proclamation under section 2 of the Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania) Act 2013

This proclamation commences certain provisions of the *Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania) Act 2013* on 10 February 2014 so that parts of the Heavy Vehicle National Law apply as a law of this jurisdiction from that date.

(2) Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania) Regulations 2014

These regulations -

- (a) modify the application, in Tasmania, of certain provisions of the *Heavy Vehicle (Vehicle Standards) National Regulation* and the *Heavy Vehicle (Mass, Dimension and Loading) National Regulation*; and
- (b) provide for the determination of the mass and dimensions of heavy vehicles and their loads; and
- (c) prescribe offences for which infringement notices may be served under the Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania).
  - (3) Proclamation under section 2(2) of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 2013

This proclamation fixes 7 February 2014 as the day on which Part 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 2013 commences.

(4) Traffic (Compliance and Enforcement) Amendment (Heavy Vehicle) Regulations 2014

These regulations amend the *Traffic (Compliance and Enforcement) Regulations 2011* by revising the schedule of traffic infringement notice offences in line with recent changes to the *Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Operations) Regulations 2001* and the *Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Standards) Regulations 2001* made consequent on the enactment of the *Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania) Act 2013*.

(5) Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Amendment (Heavy Vehicle) Regulations 2014

These regulations amend the Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2010 by prescribing new demerit points offences consequent on the enactment of the Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania) Act 2013.

(6) Vehicle and Traffic (Review of Decisions) Amendment Regulations 2014

These regulations amend the Vehicle and Traffic (Review of Decisions) Regulations 2010 by -

- (a) making a decision of the Registrar, in respect of an exemption from certain aspects of the mandatory alcohol interlock program, subject to review; and
- (b) clarifying other decisions that are subject to review.
  - (7) Vehicle and Traffic (Review of Decisions) Amendment (Heavy Vehicle) Regulations 2014

These regulations amend the Vehicle and Traffic (Review of Decisions) Regulations 2010 in line with recent changes to the Traffic Act 1925 and the Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Operations) Regulations 2001 made consequent on the enactment of the Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania) Act 2013.

(8) Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Operations) Amendment (Heavy Vehicle) Regulations 2014

These regulations amend the *Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Operations) Regulations 2001*, consequent on the enactment of the *Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania) Act 2013*, by restricting the application of certain provisions to light vehicles.

(9) Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Standards) Amendment (Heavy Vehicle) Regulations 2014

These regulations amend the *Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Standards) Regulations 2001*, consequent on the enactment of the *Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania) Act 2013*, by applying certain provisions only to light vehicles.
