LAND USE PLANNING AND APPROVALS ACT 1993

Notice of Dispensing of Requirements and Issue of Modified Planning Directive

I, BRYAN ALEXANDER GREEN, the Minister for Planning—

- (a) having considered a modification prepared by the Tasmanian Planning Commission to the planning directive entitled “Planning Directive No. 1 - The Format and Structure of Planning Schemes” (the original planning directive) and being satisfied that the modification is for the purpose of removing an anomaly, clarifying and simplifying the original planning directive and correcting errors, and that the public interest will not be prejudiced -
 - i. in pursuance of section 16 of the *Land Use Planning and Approvals Act 1993* (the Act), dispense with the requirements of sections 10, 11 and 12 of the Act in relation to the modification; and
 - ii. in pursuance of section 16 of the Act, and with reference to section 13 of the Act, give notice of the issue of the modified planning directive, entitled “Planning Directive No. 1 – The Format and Structure of Planning Schemes”, which consists of the original planning directive as modified in accordance with the modification; and
- (b) in pursuance of section 13 of the Act, specify that the modified planning directive takes effect on the date of the publication of this notice.
