I, BRYAN ALEXANDER GREEN, Minister administering the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*, pursuant to Section 94 of that Act, for the quota period from 1 March 2014 to 28 February 2015, hereby:

1. Set the total allowable catch for the commercial rock lobster fishery and the recreational rock lobster fishery combined at 1,220.70 tonnes;
