#### NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF STATUTORY RULES

#### GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT of THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

##### (1) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Land Use Planning and Approvals Amendment Act 2013*

This proclamation fixes 3 July 2014 as the day on which sections 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 24, 28(a) and (b) and 29(a) of the *Land Use Planning and Approvals Amendment Act 2013* commence.

##### (2) *Land Use Planning and Approvals Amendment Regulations 2014*

These regulations amend the *Land Use Planning and Approvals Regulations 2004* by –

- (a) prescribing the matters to be taken into account in deciding permit applications where the permit could not be granted unless a dispensation from a local provision of an interim planning scheme were granted; and
- (b) prescribing the notice required to be given of the modification of a planning scheme after the grant of such a dispensation; and

(c) updating a cross reference.
