NOTICE - DATES OF THE CLOSED SEASON FOR PART OF THE COMMERCIAL ABALONE FISHERY IN STATE WATERS OFF THE FREYCINET PENINSULA ON THE EAST COAST OF TASMANIA

I, ROBERT GOTT, A/General Manager (Water and Marine Resources), acting under Rule 9 of the *Fisheries (Abalone) Rules 2009*, and delegated authority under Section 20(1) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*, hereby determine that the dates of the closed season for that part of the commercial abalone fishery for the taking of abalone (genus *Haliotis*) for commercial purpose from State waters off the Freycinet Peninsula on the east coast of Tasmania are as follow:

from 4 June 2014 to 31 December 2014 inclusive;

where "State waters off the Freycinet Peninsula" is defined to mean: State waters off the east coast of Tasmania bounded in the north by the line of latitude 41° 47' 20" South, bounded in the west by the line of longitude 148° 08' 34" East, bounded in the east by the line of longitude 148° 35' 44.30" East and bounded in the south by the line of latitude 42° 30' 25.30" South.

GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Building Amendment Regulations 2014

These regulations amend the Building Regulations 2004 by -

(a) clarifying the adoption of the Building Code of Australia as part of those regulations; and

(b) giving effect to a new flood standard referred to in that Building Code; and

(c) amending definitions relating to bushfire-prone areas; and

(d) clarifying that agricultural crop protection polytunnels do not require a building permit; and

(e) making other minor amendments.

(2) Inland Fisheries (Recreational Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2014

These regulations amend the Inland Fisheries (Recreational Fishing) Regulations 2009 by -

(a) clarifying the boundaries of certain areas of inland waters; and

(b) removing references to areas that are no longer inland waters; and

(c) amending the maximum and minimum sizes, and bag limits, that apply to certain inland waters.
