GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Land Use Planning and Approvals Regulations 2014

These regulations -

- (a) provide for the advertisement of certain exhibitions under the Land Use Planning and Approvals Act 1993; and
- (b) prescribe the notice requirements for certain exhibitions, approvals and applications under that Act; and
- (c) prescribe certain fees payable under that Act; and
- (d) prescribe matters to be taken into account in deciding permit applications made under section 30R(1) of that Act; and
- (e) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Land Use Planning and Approvals Regulations 2004* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

These regulations -

(2) Long Service Leave (State Employees) Regulations 2014

- (a) prescribe certain offices and holidays for the purposes of the Long Service Leave (State Employees) Act 1994; and
- (b) prescribe the form and manner in which an appeal under that Act is to be instituted; and
- (c) are made consequentially on the repeal of the Long Service Leave (State Employees) Regulations 2004 under section 11 of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1992.
