Firstly;

  - (i) construct a road to the specification determined by TI in its absolute and unfettered discretion; and
  - (ii) to replace, relocate, remove, operate, modify, maintain, enhance, inspect and repair that road.

Secondly;

All "Ancillary Rights", "Exercise of Rights" and "Qualifications" as detailed in this Schedule.

"Ancillary Rights" mean TI may:

- (a) enter and remain on the land over which the Access Easement exists for the purpose of exercising any of the other rights conferred by the Access Easement; and
- (b) take onto or remove from the land over which the Access Easement exists anything, which TI considers reasonably necessary or desirable to exercise the other rights conferred by the Access Easement including without limitation, any plant, machines, vehicles, equipment or materials.

"Exercise of Rights" means rights conferred on TI by the Access Easement may be exercised by:

- (c) TI;
- (d) the operators, contractors, servants, employees, agents, work personnel, financiers, licensees, and consultants of TI land
- (e) any person acting on behalf of OR authorised by TI.

"The Property" means the land shown as lot 1 on P170188.

"Qualifications" mean the rights conferred on TI by the Access Easement are qualified to the extent that in exercising the rights:

- (f) the person exercising those rights must do as little damage as reasonably practicable;
