GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Electricity Supply Industry Amendment Regulations 2016

These regulations prescribe certain temporary electricity generators to be of minor environmental impact for the purposes of sections 52(5) and 57(b) of the *Electricity Supply Industry Act 1995*.

(2) Road Amendment (Motor Bike Helmet) Rules 2016

These rules amend the *Road Rules 2009* by providing that motor bike helmets that comply with the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe Regulation known as ECE22.05 or, more commonly, as UN Regulation No. 22 are also approved motor bike helmets for those rules.
