

ANTI-DISCRIMINATION ACT 1998

ANTI-DISCRIMINATION COMMISSIONER, TASMANIA

EXEMPTION/S GRANTED

THE following application for exemption from the provisions of the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1998* (Tas) (the Act) has been granted:

1. Archdiocese of Hobart's CatholicCare Tasmania – 15/12/047
– Application for an exemption granted under section 57 of the Act for a period of three years.

This exemption has been granted to permit the Archdiocese of Hobart's CatholicCare Tasmania to advertise and employ a male person in the position of Family Counsellor/ Family and Relationship Counsellor on the basis that:

- a) the discrimination is for the purposes of enabling the Archdiocese of Hobart's CatholicCare Tasmania service of family and relationship counselling and specialised family violence programs to provide therapeutic services to individuals, couples, families and in particular children where the gender of the counsellor is an important consideration to ensure the particular needs of the client are met;
- b) the discrimination is for the purposes of enabling the Archdiocese of Hobart's CatholicCare Tasmania service of family and relationship counselling and specialised family violence programs to continue to provide a year-round, on-going, psycho-educational group program for men who use abusive behaviours in their families through CatholicCare's Challenging Abusive Behaviours Program (CAB);
- c) being male is a genuine occupational requirement of working directly with men and children who require specialised counselling and family services provided by the Archdiocese of Hobart's CatholicCare Tasmania; and

d) the discrimination is for the purposes of enabling the Archdiocese of Hobart's CatholicCare Tasmania service of family and relationship counselling and specialised family violence to specifically allocate a male counsellor to male adults and children and other specific programs, where necessary and appropriate; and

e) the discrimination is for the purposes of enabling the Archdiocese of Hobart's CatholicCare Tasmania service of family and relationship counselling and specialised family violence programs continue to fill at least two (2) of the positions of Family Counsellor/Family & Relationship Counsellor in Southern Tasmania with men, should one of the positions become vacant at any time during the exemption period.

Granted on the 2nd day of February 2016.

The exemption is for the period of three years subject to the fulfilment of the conditions that the Archdiocese of Hobart's CatholicCare Tasmania:

- a) reports on or before 31 July 2016 to the Anti-Discrimination Commissioner on actions taken in reliance on this exemption; and
- b) on at least one occasion in the 12 months immediately after this order is made, organise and promote community education for its staff, members, officers and clients of the Archdiocese of Hobart's CatholicCare Tasmania through Equal Opportunity Tasmania's community education program to increase awareness of rights and obligations under the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1998* (Tas).

A person may apply to the Anti-Discrimination Tribunal for a review of the Commissioner's decision within 28 days from the date of this notice being published.
